NDAA FY2010 requires the repeal of NSPS. The position(s) covered by this vacancy announcement is scheduled to transition from NSPS to GS or an applicable personnel system no later than January 1, 2012.

USACIL provides forensic laboratory support to U.S. Department of Defense (DOD) criminal investigation organizations and legal agencies, as well as other federal and non-federal agencies. The work is performed in a laboratory setting and Expeditionary Forensic Laboratories and involves recurring exposure to irritant chemicals, blood borne pathogens, gases, and laser lights. Special safety precautions are required including the occasional wearing and use of protective devices such as goggles, rubber or plastic gloves and laboratory smocks. The work environment includes office setting, laboratory conditions, crime scenes, training facilities, and courtrooms. Some situations require the use of protective equipment such as safety glasses and respirators.
